Dear Glenforest South families,

I am writing to provide an important update on the letter to families on Feb. 7, 2019. As you know, an amended staff recommendation went to the Board of Trustees on Feb. 13, 2019. The staff recommendation was approved by Trustees. As part of our commitment to keep families informed and updated, we wanted to share this information with you.

Throughout this process, we have tried to keep the best interests of students, families and staff as our top priority. However, after families had made their choices through the course selection planning process, it was determined that an insufficient number of families have selected to remain at Glenforest South and it became clear that it would not possible to offer a viable Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Vocational 1 and Vocational 2 program.

In order to ensure that affected students are successfully enrolled into courses for the 2019-20 school year, we have attached a copy of the course options for your teenager at West Credit Secondary School. Please kindly complete this form and return by Tuesday, February 19 to the Main Office.
