

## PAR implementation update

### Website post – Gordon Graydon Memorial SS

Dear Gordon Graydon Memorial Secondary School families,

As you know, last year, the Peel District School Board approved recommendations from [the Pupil Accommodation Review](#) to close Gordon Graydon and move our Vocational and Autism Spectrum Disorder programs to Glenforest Secondary School.

Construction was scheduled to begin over the summer to prepare Glenforest for these programs. As with many renovation or construction projects, there are sometimes delays beyond our control. Construction at Glenforest has been delayed until next summer and is now scheduled to be completed by September 2019—one year later than expected. **Based on these delays, the Glenforest school site will not be ready to accommodate the Vocational and ASD programs for September 2018. As a result, these Glenforest programs will be temporarily held at the Gordon Graydon Memorial building until the Glenforest school building is ready to accommodate these students in September 2019.**

We remain dedicated to continuing the strong Vocational and ASD programming and supports while the Glenforest programs are held at the Gordon Graydon Memorial building next school year.

Please note these construction delays do not impact the movement of the International Business and Technology and Graphic and Design Management Programs to TL Kennedy Secondary School. These programs will move to TL Kennedy as planned for the start of the 2018-19 school year.
