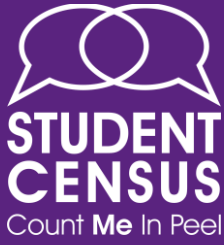


Overall Peel Board (K-12) Results by Municipality



In November 2018, the Peel District School Board launched its first Student Census to better understand students, identify and eliminate barriers to student success, inclusion and well-being, and establish programs and reallocate resources to where they are needed most. More than 127,000 Peel board students (kindergarten to grade 12) participated, with a response rate of 79.2%. This infographic outlines identity-based data for elementary and secondary students within each municipality served by the Peel board.

Number of K-12 Students and Response Rate

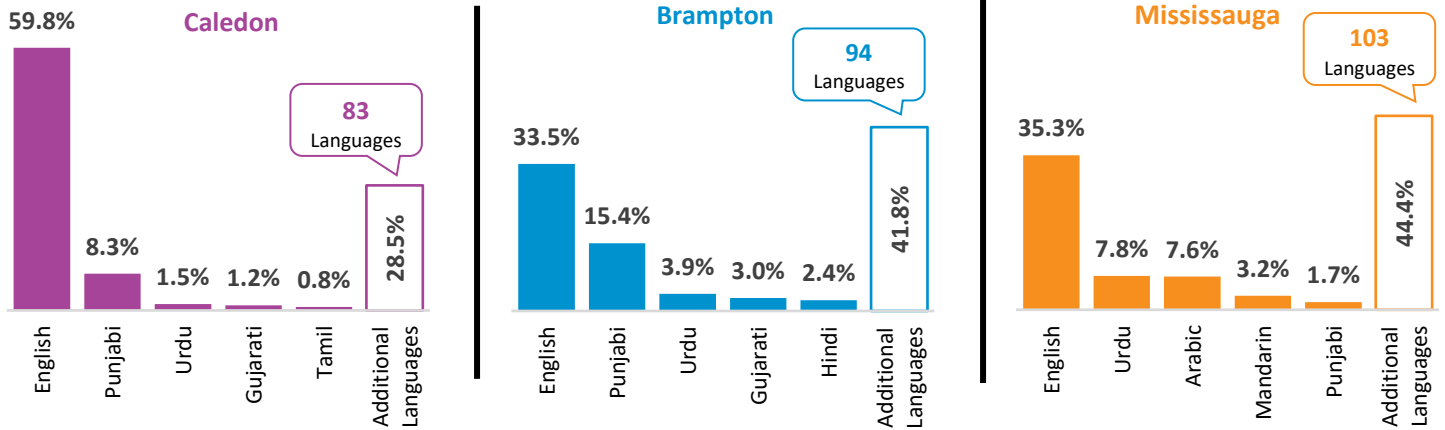

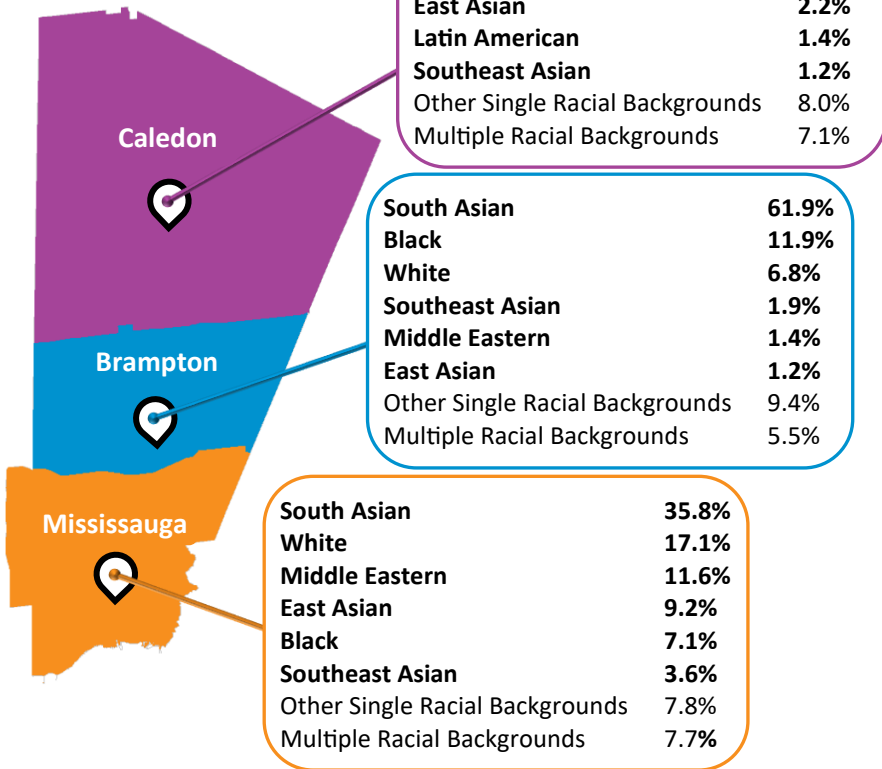

Top 5 First Languages (Mother Tongue)



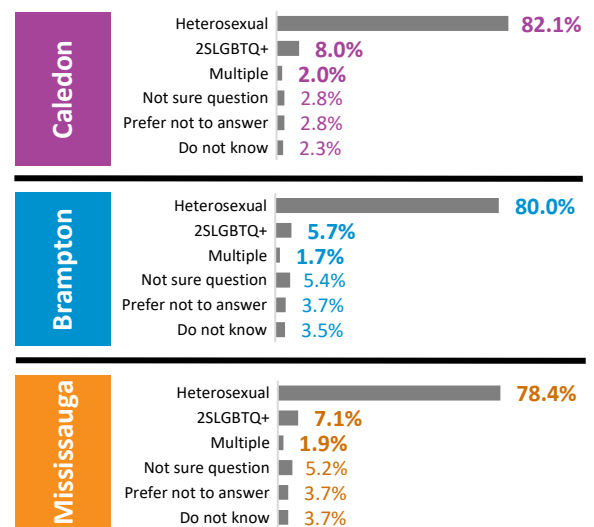
Top Racial Backgrounds

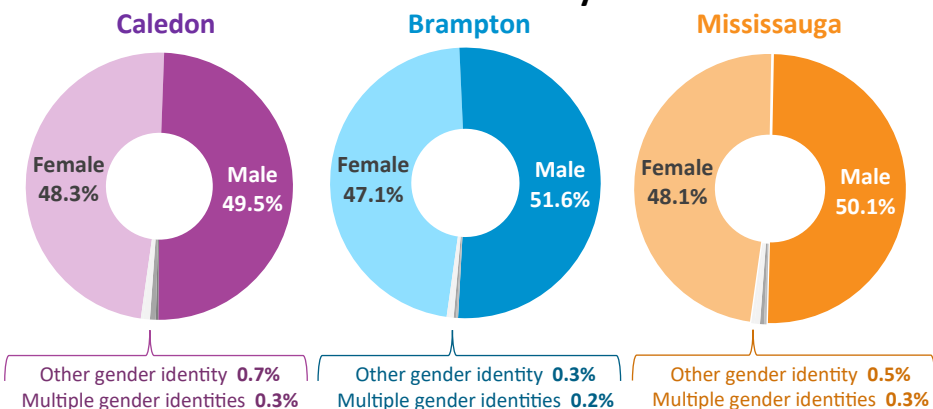
